The Community Grower Leadership programme offers field trips, practical training, talks from experts and a network gathering. With a mix of online and in person events you can tailor the programme to your own interests and build skills and knowledge where you need it most. These events will provide either key community leadership skills, practical skills or place-based inspiration.

All events are free to attend, but if you want to dive deeper and gain a certificate as an FEL Scotland recognised *Community Growing Leader*, participate in at least one event from each of our three key pillars of learning (Leadership, Practical skills, Inspration) by registering on FEL Scotland's Eventbrite page, and join our networking event (11 February 2026).
